Seminar “Morals and Markets” (Profilbereich: “Marktorientierte Unternehmensführung”)

Markets often encounter moral resistance. Philosophers such as Michael Sandel assume that certain goods or services should not be traded. Others point out that markets are the best known instrument for combating scarcity known to mankind. The seminar will focus on theoretical and empirical works that represent a moral attack on or a moral defense of markets.

In the first part, we will discuss influential papers from the field. In the second part, students will give presentations on self-selected topics from the field. Seminar performance consists in the presentation, the handing-in of a seminar paper and active discussions in class throughout the term.
